AIR SAFETY CIRCULAR NO. 5 OF 1994

Subject: Mock up Exercises by the cockpit Crew for Evacuation in Emergencies.

Cockpit Crew must be thorough and proficient in handling the emergencies like smoke, fire, forced landing and orderly evacuation of passengers on ground. A little slackness or wrong handling on their part may lead to loss of valuable lives. The aircraft crew can be trained in this aspect through mock-up exercises. Emphasis should also be laid on coordination amongst all the crew members while exercising their respective duties to ensure quick & efficient handling of emergency. Such training may be included in their annual refresher.

All operators are advised to ensure that Cockpit crew should be made proficient in handling the above mentioned emergencies. They should go through similar exercises as laid down for the cabin crew in Civil Aviation Requirements Section VII, Series M, Part I, Issue I, dated 7th May ,1993 issued by the DGCA.
