Air Safety Circular No.7 of 2009

Subject: Sale of Aircraft Accident Investigation Reports.

Copies of reports (without Appendices, Statements and Photographs etc.) of aircraft accidents investigated under Rule 71, 74, 75 & serious incidents investigated under Rule 77C of Aircraft Rules 1937 with effect from 15th July 2009 will be placed on DGCA Website. Any person who desires to obtain hard copy of the investigation report shall submit payments as detailed below:

- (i) Rs.500/ for each Investigation Report of Inspector of Accident / Investigation In-Charge under Rule 71 & 77 C
- (ii) Rs.1000/ for each Investigation Report of Court of Inquiry and Committee of Inquiry under Rule 75 and 74 respectively

2. Requests for copies of report should be accompanied with Demand Draft of appropriate amount in favour of

“PAY AND ACCOUNTS OFFICE, DIRECTOR GENERAL OF CIVIL AVIATION, MINISTRY OF CIVIL AVIATION, NEW DELHI”.

3. All requests for copies of report are to be made to Director Air Safety, Office of DGCA, Technical Centre, Opp. Safdarjung Airport, New Delhi – 110003 indicating date and place of accident; registration of Aircraft/ type of the aircraft involved in the accident/serious incident.

4. Reports to the places outside Delhi will be sent by ordinary book post.
