## A. Common instructions for all Pilot Licence Examinations.

1. Applicant should fill the
  - a) Form **CA-9( Pilot comp No.)** of latest revision for **allotment of computer No.**
  - b) Form **CA-9( Pilot-Tech)** of latest revision for **Pilot Technical** including **Flight Engineer's** Licence examination
  - c) Form **CA-9( Pilot-Gen)** of latest revision for **Pilot General** Exam
  - d) Form **CA-9( Flt.Nav./Desp)** of latest revision for **Flight Navigator / Despatcher** Exam
  - e) Form **CA-9(FIR/AFIR)** of the latest revision for **flight instructor/Assistant flight instructor rating.**

## B INSTRUCTIONS FOR PILOT'S "TECHNICAL" EXAMINATION

- Candidates can apply for only one rating to cover one type of aircraft in each session failing which his application will be rejected.
- "Type of aircraft" should be filled up with Model No. i.e. PIPER PA 18-125, For model of aircraft, refer to aircraft flight manual / POH.
- The applicant appearing on Heavy Airplanes or Multi-Engine Helicopters for papers 2 & 3 must submit a copy of a Certificate of successful completion of approved course. Such applications should be submitted through sponsoring organization only. In case of defence personnel he/she should submit a certificate about having flown as commander on that type of aircraft.

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
