**Subject: Mandatory equipage of GAGAN on the aircraft to be registered in India.**

With the launch of GAGAN, India has become the fourth country in the world to have satellite-based navigation system technology. However, most aircraft currently registered in India are not equipped to utilise this technology. Subpara (d) of para 14 of the National Civil Aviation Policy states **“All aircraft being registered in India from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2019 will mandatorily have to be GAGAN enabled.”**

In view of the above, all the aircraft being imported for registration on or after 01.01.2019 shall be required to be suitably equipped with GAGAN equipment. Accordingly, a provision to this effect has been included in the relevant Air Transport Circular 02/2017 (revising the existing ATC 01/2016) containing the procedure for obtaining permission for import/acquisition of aircraft.
