PUBLIC NOTICE

DGCA approves AME Training Institutes to impart ab-initio training in the field of aircraft maintenance. The National Civil Aviation Policy clearly states "MoCA will endeavour to have the Flight Training Schools, Aircraft Maintenance Engineering Schools and other training schools providing training in the aviation sector registered/ recognised under law or as a part of an approved vocational education course or as training partners approved by the National Skill Development Corporation or the Sector Skill Council".

In-line with the National Civil Aviation Policy, the University Grants Commission, in consultation with Ministry of Civil Aviation has introduced a B.Sc (Hons) course in Aircraft Maintenance and a template for model syllabus has been published which is available on UGC website site at http://www.ugc.ac.in/pdfnews/0259615_BSc-Hons-Aircraft-Final-Syllabus.pdf.

The training institutes may use the template for obtaining affiliation with UGC recognized University for higher learning.
