Specifications for Florescent Jacket / Safety Vest

The vest should provide the same qualities even when ambient light of street lights, vehicle headlamps or other forms of lighting is present in work places. It should be conspicuous in rainy, hazy, misty, foggy conditions & under any light condition by day and under illumination by vehicle headlights in the dark.

The vest should be designed, manufactured, stitched and constructed as per International Standards for high visibility warning clothing. The fluorescent background material i.e. fabric should be of fluorescent orange colour and the fabric should be **Polyester-Cotton with 65% Polyester and 35% Cotton and adhere to International specifications** with the manufacturer's certificate for Hi visibility warning garments

1. The vest should have Two 50mm vertical band of Silver Glass bead type tapes running from shoulder to chest joining the band at the chest. The vest should have one horizontal band in front and back. The band around the chest should be in straight line and match near the point where hook and loop/fasteners /closers are stitched. Arm cut should be at reasonable length.
- 2 There should not be any joints at sides and the shoulders of the vest 100% polyester 3-ply thread should be used for stitching and colour of the thread be matched with the colour of the fabric wherever the colour combination is required. The dye-colour of the thread should be fast & it should not fade.
3. The vest should provide 360 degree fluorescence.
4. At the back of the jacket “DGCA” should be woven.

1. The scope of this tender is to invite offers for supply of items of “Accident Investigation Kits” from reputed suppliers.
2. The tender should be quoted for all items mentioned in the Annexure-I,
3. The tender will be considered on the basis of total price of the kits.
4. Warranty period for each item may be clearly specified as per OEM specification.
5. The rates should be quoted in figures clearly. Deviation, if any, from the specifications will not be accepted. Correction in “Rate” column, if any, should be duly authenticated.
6. A Bank Draft for an amount of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) payable to the “PAO, DGCA, Ministry of Civil Aviation, New Delhi” has to be enclosed as Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) for safeguarding the interest of the DGCA in all respects along with the Quotation/Tender. Tender(s) received without “EMD” will not be considered. EMD of a tenderer will be forfeited, if the tenderer withdraws or amends its tender or impairs or derogates from the tender in any respect. The said “Security deposit” will be refunded on the successful completion of the contract after deductions, if any.
7. Any loss sustained by the Department as a result of non-compliance with delivery schedule, questionable quality of terms and short delivery shall be recoverable from the tenderer out of the Security Deposit.
8. **The tenderer must be registered with Sales Tax Department and a copy of registration certificate to this effect, duly signed and stamped by the authorized person of the company must be enclosed with the tender.**
9. **‘TIN’ No. of the firm as applicable while submitting the tender, must be indicated. A tender lacking this will not be considered.**

10. The contract will preferably be awarded to the lowest tenderer amongst the technically qualified bidders.

11. The items as per the approved specifications should be supplied within 15 days from the date of receipt of the purchase order failing which a penalty would be imposed (equal to 1% of indent cost per day of delay, in case of further delay beyond one month the order is liable to be cancelled and the EMD forfeited, if the delay is attributable to the supplier.

12. If the items supplied are not found up to the approved specifications, or, are not delivered within the stipulated time, the security deposit may also be forfeited at the discretion of DGCA.

13. **The rates are to be quoted on the company's letter head. Each page of the quotation/tender must be signed & stamped by the authorized Signatory. Unsigned quotations may not be considered.**

14. **Technical & Financial bids should be submitted separately in sealed cover and both these sealed covers should be put in a big cover which should also be sealed and super-sealed covers should be put in a big cover which should also be sealed and super-sealed as 'Quotation for Accident Investigation Kit'.**

15. **A certificate should be given with the technical bid that each item is as per specification mentioned in Annexure-A1 to A-7. EMD can be forfeited in case of violation.**

16. Tender Documents not properly sealed will not be considered.

17. DGCA, New Delhi, reserves the right to accept or reject any or all of the bids in full or in part including the lowest, without assigning any reason thereof or incurring any liability thereby.
